Niramax Group Limited is a waste management company that specialises in recycling commercial, industrial and household waste and diverting waste from Landfill. Our aim is to provide a total waste management service to our customers, which includes collection and processing of all waste through our Materials Recycling Facility (MRF) and Refuse Derived Fuel (RDF) plant in Hartlepool. Thus maximising our recycling and recovery rates through waste to energy channels and minimising our disposal to landfill.

The Niramax Group recognises the need to operate its business in a manner that reflects sound environmental management balancing the business aims of the company with the need to manage and protect the environment. The group will take into account all relevant environmental factors over which it can have influence and control when making business decisions. To this end Niramax will, as a minimum strive to prevent pollution by:

- The establishment and upkeep of an environmental management system which conforms to ISO 14001 with the involvement of upper tier management inputs.
- Considering the waste hierarchy in deciding the most appropriate waste management option for waste collected and processed.
- Continually seek to improve the environmental performance of our activities, products and services, and systems that they support.
- Ensuring that all outlets for residue waste including but not limited to Recyclates/SRF-RDF materials are valid, approved and licensed.
- Operating in a manner controlling releases to the air, water, and land.
- Establishing a framework for setting environmental objectives and associated targets.
- Communicating the policy to all employees and others working on behalf of Niramax, and making our policy available to the public.
- Training employees and ensuring that they are competent to undertake their duties in accordance with the Environmental Policy, procedures and in a manner that facilitates achievement of objectives and targets.

The Niramax Group will comply with all relevant environmental legislation and Regulations and other environmental requirements applicable to our environmental aspects and act openly with government officials at all levels to ensure full compliance with such requirements.

This statement and policy not only provides an important statement of intent against which the Organisation will be judged, but also provides a lead for others to follow.

This statement and policy has been reviewed in line with the Organisation's ISO 14001 certification, formalized and endorsed by the Managing Director who takes responsibility for its execution and to ensure it is a prime concern to employees at all levels.
